ADOLESCENT PROGRAMS

The County of San Diego provides developmentally appropriate substance use disorder (SUD) treatment services and recovery programs to help youth reach their full potential by achieving a substance free lifestyle. These programs provide treatment for adolescents and their families, ensure access to care, and promote self-sufficiency through education and/or employment. Services are offered throughout the county in urban and rural communities, and include outpatient treatment, crisis intervention, and residential treatment services.

Access to Services

Services shall not be refused to clients based on race/ ethnicity, disability, culture, religion, gender, sexual orientation, or the inability to pay, if the client meets the County's eligibility population requirements. Clients who are CalWORKs eligible shall not be charged fees. Clients who are DMC eligible shall not be charged fees unless there is Share of Cost (SOC).
